### Science

Our topic this half term is: ***Animals including humans.*** During this topic we will be:

- Describe the simple functions of the basic parts of the digestive system in humans
- Identify the different types of teeth in humans and their simple functions.
- Construct and interpret a variety of food chains, identifying producers, predators and prey.

### Computing

During our computing lessons this half term, we will be focusing on our Information Technology Skills. We will complete the following activities:

- Typing skills
- Basic word processing
- Digital painting

### Art and D&T

During this topic we will be:

- Exploring hieroglyphics
- Creating our own Egyptian jewelry.
- Making our own Canopic jars.
- Creating an Egyptian landscape using water colours.

### Maths

Along with daily arithmetic and times tables sessions, this half term we will be exploring measurement and perimeter of shapes, multiplication and division.

- Convert between m and km
- Find the perimeter of a shape on a grid.
- Find the perimeter of a rectangle
- Find the perimeter of rectilinear shapes.
- Multiply and divide by 10, 100 and 1000
- Multiplying by 6,7 and 9

### English

This half term, the key text focus will be Lost happy endings. During this unit we will:

- Understand expanding noun phrases.
- Explore the language used in the text.
- Explore onomatopoeia
- Gather vocabulary including similes, metaphors, powerful verbs and adverbs to write a poem.
- Explore characters and settings in the story writing complex sentences to help write descriptions.
- Write a job advert and then apply for the job.
- Write a story ending in the style of the author.

### History/Geography

We will be focusing on the history of Ancient Egypt. Looking at their daily lives, their culture and how they survived, comparing this to our lives today. We will look at the Geography of Egypt, More specifically, where Egypt is in the world and how they used the River Nile to support themselves. Finally, we will also be exploring the findings of the famous Archaeologist Howard Carter.

### R.E.

Our topic this half term is: ***Family and Baptism.***

During these topics we will learn to know and understand:

- The many beginnings each day offers.
- That God is present in every beginning.
- The signs and symbols of Baptism.
- Acquire the skills of assimilation, celebration and application of the above.
