Dear Parents/Carers,

We are currently reviewing our medical records. Please can I draw your attention to the following –

- [1] If your child has asthma, we must have an 'in-date' inhaler in school, along with their spacer.
- [2] If your child has an allergy which requires an EpiPen, we must have two 'in-date' EpiPens in school.
- [3] If your child has either an EpiPen and/or inhaler, then you MUST fill in a care-plan at the office, otherwise we are unable to administer these medicines.
- [4] If your child has allergies which do not require an EpiPen, then please notify us AT THE OFFICE immediately, along with any medication they require. This will need to be added to a care-plan.
- [5] If your child has Piriton, or other similar medicines for allergies, then you MUST provide school with their own bottle which must be put on a care-plan at the office.
