In science, we will be identifying and classifying a range of materials and their properties; whilst working scientifically.

Music

Maths

In maths, we will be building on our addition and subtraction skills to 10. We will then explore place value to 20. This will include reading and writing numbers to 20, ordering and comparing numbers and finding one more and one less. Through our provision areas in the classroom the children will also be introduced to lessons focusing on length and height and mass and volume of objects.

English

Our book focus this half term is 'Paddington'. We will use this text for a range of writing outcomes. We will be working on using our phonics to segment words for writing and structuring sentences with capital letters, finger gaps and full stops. We will also work on extending our sentences with the use of 'and'. Additionally, we will have daily 'Read, Write Inc' sessions to build on our phonics, reading and writing skills.
