Science

In science, we will be naming and classifying animals and identifying their body parts; with a focus on polar animals.

English

Additionally, we will have daily 'Read, Write Inc' sessions to build on our phonics, reading and writing skills.

Art

We will be creating landscapes using different media. In doing this, we will develop our drawing, painting, colour mixing and collage skills.

History and Geography

We will be locating the continents, Equator, North Pole and South Pole. We will then look at Antarctica further and the expedition of Captain Robert Falcon Scott. Whilst doing this, we will ask questions and use a range of sources to gather information.
