St Mary's School Car Park

The Governors would like to remind you that it is an expectation that parents should not be driving into the school car park when dropping off or collecting their children.

At the discretion of the Headteacher a limited number of parents with Disability Badges have been granted access to the school car park. However, it has been noted that other parents are tailgating cars and accessing the school park.

There has been an increasing number of parents who have been driving into the car park which is causing a lot of congestion at the beginning and end of each day. This congestion is causing safety issues and has recently resulted in a collision between two cars, neither of which had approval to be in the car park.

We ask for your support in making a change to this practice by parking further away from school. You and your child/children may need to walk a little further from your car to school but, this will improve safety for all.

Thank you in advance for supporting and respecting the ethos, vision and values of our school as we work together with staff, to ensure the best possible interests of our children.

Please remember to treat all members of the school community with respect and setting a good example with speech and behaviour.
