## English

In English, we will be writing in role, thinking about characterisation, using different genres of text to work on formality of tone and we will continue to look at complex sentences. We will be doing much of our work based around the United States and also a very courageous man called Philippe Petit.

## Topic

During this topic, we will be using procedural skills as well as conceptual skills to look at physical and human features of places within the United States. We will start off by looking at maps of North and South America and move in to using geographical language to explain our preferences. We will also plan and carry out fieldwork in the local area to compare Middleton, Greater Manchester, to Middletons across America.
