Dear Parents/Carers,

I hope this letter finds you and your families safe and well.

As you are aware, we have been offering pupils, whose parents receive benefit-related free school meals, a daily grab-bag. (Please note that this is not the same as 'Universal Infant Free School Meals'). These have been offered since the start of lockdown and can be collected from the school office.

From the week commencing 6th July, we will now be offering the choice of a daily grab bag or a weekly food hamper which can be collected from the school office. The hamper would contain:

- a loaf of bread,
- 1 tin of meatballs or hoops
- pasta sauce or soup
- 100g block of cheddar cheese
- 100g pasta
- 1 800g tin of beans
- 200g potatoes
- 200g carrots
- 2 packets raisins
- 2 oranges
- 1 litre fresh milk

So we can process the order in plenty of time, please advise us if you require a food hamper or a daily grab bag no later than 3pm on Tuesday 30th June. Please contact the school office on 0161 643 7594.

During the summer holidays, we will not be providing grab bags or hampers, and instead will move to the Free School Meal voucher scheme. This is because our school kitchen will not be open during the holidays. We will give you further information about this in due course.
