

Welcome back...

When you come back to school, things may look and feel a bit different so that we can all stay safe. But just remember that we are so happy to see you again.

Here are some things that will be different in school, which will help to keep everyone safe:

You will be in a 'bubble' with your year group and year group adults. You will have to stay in these bubbles and not mix with children in other bubbles. This is important to keep everyone safe.

You will come back to school in your normal uniform with black shoes/trainers. For PE you will only need to bring in pumps/trainers.

It is important to keep everywhere and everything as clean as possible so you will see adults cleaning tables and equipment.

When you come back you will be encouraged to keep a distance from others. This includes your teachers. But don't worry we will talk to you about this when you come into school.

There will be toilets that only your bubble can use.

The tables will be all facing the front and you will have your very own special place to sit every time you are in school.

If you have an accident teachers will put on face coverings and gloves to help you.

You will have to wash your hands at different times throughout the day with soap and warm water/hand sanitiser which is outside each classroom - just like we did before we took a break.

Only 1 adult will be able to drop you off and pick you up from school.

Playtime
You and your bubble (year group) will have your own pitch to play on at break times and lunch times. When you are playing teachers will encourage you to try to stay socially distant.

You will have your very own set of stationery to use (you do not need to bring your own). This will mean that only you can use it. We usually enjoy sharing at St Mary's, but for now, it is important that we look after our own things.

If you cough or sneeze you will be taught to "Catch it, Kill it, Bin it" or use your elbow to cough.

LUNCH

You will have a packed lunch either from home or school in September. You will eat your lunch in your classroom at your own desk.

It is also important that you stay sat down in class - which we do very well at St Mary's already. If you need anything just put your hand up and a teacher will answer you.

Other resources that you may use for maths or science will be cleaned regularly.

We know this is a lot to remember, so don't worry if you forget! Your teachers will explain things when you are in school.

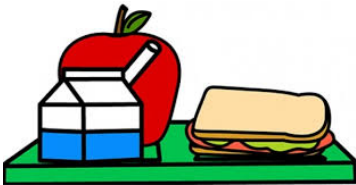
