Today's Reading

The readings for this Sunday focus on themes of discipleship, peace, and God's abundant harvest. Jesus sends out his disciples in pairs to prepare the way for him, emphasizing the importance of peace and welcoming the message of the Gospel.



Thought for the Day – Henri Amyl, a Swiss philosopher, wrote about the importance of simplicity: 'All of us are generally bound up with hindrances and duties that wind about us like a spider's web that restricts our movement. In order to simplify our duties and lives we must know how to disengage what is essential from the detail in which it is entrapped. It is a lack of order that makes us slaves'. Pope John XXIII once said, 'I must strip my views of all useless foliage and concentrate on what is truth, justice and charity'.
