

# Science

We will be learning all about Materials in Science this half term, completing lots of experiments to understand terms such as mixture, solution, dissolve, soluble, insoluble, filtration, sieving, sorting.

Spelling and handwriting are both priorities for our class. We will be basing our writing this half term around the book 'Adventures of Odysseus'. Focussing on story-telling, information texts and diary entries. We will continue to work on handwriting and choosing vocabulary for effect. We will be moving through the Y5 grammar and punctuation curriculum using relative clauses, subordination and starting to look at parenthesis

# Music
